



**LEADING PT.**  
Fish the south end of the point on an ebb tide for salmon.

**SPITTER PT.**  
Very small tack, fish the point around the seine tie.

**THE SLASH**  
Better on a flood tide.

**SLOP BUCKET**  
Good on both tides.

**ALLATT PT.**  
Ebb tide.

**CHICKEN PT.**  
Seems to produce better at first and last light.

**YORK PT.**  
Good on both tides, fish the west side of the point all the way down into the bay.

**BAIT TANK**  
Best on an ebb tide.

**MCNEIL PT.**  
Good for Coho in July.

**FAWCETT PT.**  
Best for Coho in July but worth a check for Springs when coming to or from Dougan.

**DOUGAN PT.**  
Good on both tides, a little better on the flood.

**RED BEACH**  
Good on both tides.

**ECLIPSE**  
Good on both tides however the ebb tide runs really fast on big tide changes.

**CLARKE COVE**  
Better on flood tide. Can be a crowded area.

**TEFLON BAY**  
Fish the north end on an ebb tide. Fish the south end on a flood tide.

**SEABROOK**  
Fish the south side of the point during an ebb tide.

**THE WALL**  
Fish one line deeper and stick tight to the wall.

**WATERFALL**  
Can produce on both tides but seems better on the flood.

**REDFERN PT.**  
Best fishing is when the low slack starts to flood.
