Ready for great fishing? The West Coast team will greet you at the dock and fit you with a personalized floater suit and rubber boots. We'll rig you up with top-quality tackle, built to withstand repeated 100+ yard runs from king salmon, and wild, ripping coho that can top 15 pounds. We'll outfit you with a comfortable, deep-hulled boat. If you want to fish without having to handle the boat or cut bait, we'll provide you with complete guide service. Either way, once you're out on the water the fish won't stand a chance.

Each day our instructors coach you on the how-tos of catching the really big salmon before directing you to the area's hot spots. There is no limit to the amount of time you can spend on the water. If your aching arms can take it, a marathon dawn-to-dusk day is entirely possible. If you decide to sleep in one morning or cruise around scenic St. John's Harbour to take in views of the abundant sea and wildlife, that's fine. The fish will be there when you're ready to head back out.

There are other fish at Milbanke too. Massive, rod-stressing halibut, ling cod, a variety of bottom fish, and pink and chum salmon that are always fun to catch, especially on light tackle. When it comes to great fishing, Milbanke is it.

Content to stay in one place, where the whims of the salmon gods determine when the fish are there? Or would you rather stay at a first-class resort that moves into the Milbanke Sound area only when the salmon runs are at their peak? In mid-July the resort moves into Milbanke Sound and operates until early September — prime time! No shoulder season fisheries here — from Day 1 the fishing at Milbanke Sound is fantastic.
